



Job: Associate Clinician

Job description: Ancora Counseling and Therapy Services is seeking an Associate Clinician. Associate Clinician will provide outpatient individual and group therapy to clients of Ancora. Therapy services include treatment of children, adolescents, adults, couples, and/or families. We are currently looking for licensed or unlicensed therapists, counselors, social workers, and/or psychologists who are anti-racist, social justice minded, and ready to be a part of a dynamic, fun, and collaborative team.

This is a remote or hybrid part-time position, starting at 15 hours per week with room to grow immediately based on caseload and desire.

Responsibilities:

Associate Clinician has the following responsibilities

- Maintenance of a caseload including but not limited to consultations, intake assessments, counselor, crisis calls, and/or case management.
- Timely completion of documentation/notes.
- Timely responsiveness to client emails and phone calls.
- Securely maintaining client and company data and interests.
- Utilization of EHR and payroll calendars
- Attend supervision with administrative/clinical supervisor
- Work independently during remote time
- Submit invoices and collect client payments at time of service.
- Other duties as required.

Requirements:

Associate clinician should have the following skills, education and experience:

- Master's degree in social work, counseling, or similar field
- 3 years experience in the mental health field (preferred, not required)
- Licensure or intern status with the State of Oregon.
